She will give Jan Richards (KCEDF) the plaque for the Jackson Barn until the best method of installation on the wood buildings is determined. Richards will talk to Brad Semmens about installing the plaques for the Legion Hall and the Barn into a stone in order to prevent vandalism since those buildings are more prone to it than the others. Plaques for buildings that are under construction will be passed onto the owners of each building to be installed as appropriate once construction is completed.
