Regular Meeting
September 12, 2016

- I. Call to Order: Roberts called the meeting to order at 6:40 p.m.
- II. Agenda approval: Spady moved to approve the agenda; Barlow seconded. Agenda approved.
- III. Opening Remarks: none
- IV. Approval of Minutes: Barlow moved to approve minutes from the July meeting; Campbell seconded. Minutes approved.
- V. Reports
 - a. Roberts sent in the CLG report in August. Rodman confirmed receiving it; Courkamp will post it on our webpage.
 - b. Roberts noted that there is a CLG training in Lamar on September 27 and 28 (two options). Spady may attend.
 - c. Richards asked if NPS will have leftover funds to be used on the Murdock building; Roberts reported that it's possible, but they will not know for sure until Sept. 23. The funds, if available, will be used for interior design and construction drawings.
- VI. Unfinished Business
 - a. Rodman requested a copy of the initial CLG agreement; Courkamp and Roberts will continue searching.
 - b. Roberts will email the owner of the Hotel Holly to see if they are interested in pursuing an emergency grant to remove the large tree that fell near the hotel during a storm this summer. Spady has a couple photographs that clearly show the danger to the building. Spady is going to get a current address so that Roberts can ask for permission.
 - c. Courkamp will bring the final draft of the updated brochure to the next meeting for commission approval. She will also work on updating the website.
 - d. Courkamp still needs to look into necessary updates for the commission laptop.
- VII. New Business
 - a. Roberts will contact Mark Rodman to schedule a training (possibly in October) that focuses on tax credits. Chamber After Hours may be a possible venue.
 - b. Grants: The commission discussed the possibility of pursuing a grant to nominate the Towner Bus Tragedy landscape as a cultural landscape. The other idea is to pursue a grant to map the historic sites in the county – simply make the map and let go of the idea of making it interactive. It's possible that we may not need a grant to get this information on a map.
